## Rules, Regulations & norms applicable

1. The Student should wear their valid College ID CARD through out the day and even in Dining Hall.
2. Rooms should be kept neat, fresh and tidy.
3. Garbage should be put in the Dustbin only. For the transit of garbage from the room to the main dustbins kept in each floor, students should use the dustbins given in each room. They should not throw the garbage into the corridor and other areas.
4. Drying clothes on Railings and Parapet walls in the corridor is strictly prohibited.
5. Furniture should be only in the place initially planned for and cannot be moved.
6. No posters are allowed to be pasted on the walls and doors. Violation of this will attract heavy penalty.
7. During the college hours students cannot stay back in the hostel without the permission of the principal/warden and after the college hours they cannot leave the hostel for any reason without the permission of the Chief Warden.
8. 7.00 p.m. to 7.00 a.m. is specified as study hours. During these hours:
  - a. Every student should strictly be in his room, except during dining.
  - b. Students are generally not allowed to go to other rooms for borrowing materials such as notes, calculators, medicines, etc., which will result in unwanted problems.
  - c. Transistors and CD Players are normally not allowed. If they are desirous of using them (with prior permission from the warden), can only be used with head phones.
  - d. No combined studies/discussions are allowed in the rooms.
9. Birthday, Festival and other celebrations are not allowed inside the campus.
10. When called for a meeting the attendance is compulsory & should be punctual.
11. Any sort of fighting and Man handling are not allowed and if any one attempt to do such things, will be viewed very seriously and take necessary action.
12. If the student notices any problem/discrepancy the same should be brought to the notice of the undersigned immediately.
13. Hostel authorities are empowered to enter the room at any point of time (even in the midnight) to inspect the room and belongings of the students. No resistance can be offered by the inmates. They must also co-operate in completing the inspection. Resistance offered is considered as violation of norms.
14. Local guardian (LG): Parents will have to identify the local guardian. The local guardian should be an elderly (above 35 years) person. The age factor may be relaxed only in the case of LG being the own brother/ sister working in Bangalore. The LG will have to respond to the request of the hostel authorities from time to time.
15. Students are allowed to visit the LGs with prior permission, only once a week. They will have to seek permission of the warden, to visit the LG, in the prescribed format one day in advance. While returning, the signature of the LG is to be obtained in the prescribed format. Any body visits the LG without the permission of the warden the same will be treated as violation of rules. Only on Saturday or Sunday students can go out for any purchase/ entertainment with the written permission of the Warden. They should return before the specified time. As soon as they return they should register their return with the warden.
16. No Guests including relatives and family members are allowed to enter the hostel. They can only meet their ward in the Reception Room. Visitors other than Parents may not be allowed to visit unless the Warden is totally convinced and the Warden's decision to permit or not is final.
17. The guests are requested to report at reception for needful.
18. Use of Electrical Heater/ Appliances are strictly banned.

19. \*\*Smoking & Consuming alcohol by any inmate either inside or outside the hostel is strictly prohibited. Any such related material found in the room amounts to serious violation of the hostel norms.
20. Usage of drug and any illegal activities in the campus is strictly prohibited.
21. The Dress Code is to be strictly followed. (Annexure - 1).
22. \*\* Ragging is strictly prohibited. Even any attempt to rag is considered an unforgivable offense.
23. \*\*Use & possessing of any inflammable/explosive material (including crackers) in any form is strictly prohibited.
24. \*\* Going on Picnic/ visits is strictly prohibited. Students violating are solely responsible for the consequences arising out of violation. The college will in no way be responsible for the consequences and such students will be sent out of the hostel and the college without any further notice.
25. Any sort of vandalizing is not allowed in the campus.
26. Use of mobiles should not create problems in the hostel.
27. Students leaving the hostel in the middle of the academic year on their own or have been because asked to vacate the hostel on disciplinary measure, will forfeit the entire amount paid to the hostel including the caution deposit.
28. The period of accommodation in the hostel is for one academic year in which the inmates seeks admission to the hostel, and not for one calendar year.
29. Use of PCs/ Laptop are allowed only with prior permission as per the norms of the Hostel. Any software is subject to scrutiny by the hostel authorities. Materials which are objectionable will be confiscated as a disciplinary measure.
30. When students are going out of the hostel on short term/ mid term vacation, they have to take prior permission from the Warden and they have to get a letter signed by their parents in the prescribed format while returning. Going without permission under any circumstances is treated as violation of rules.
31. When the inmates are vacating the hostel they have to intimate the Warden in advance. If anybody vacates the hostel without fulfilling the formalities, it amounts to violation of the hostel rules. Their belongings (if any) will be seized and the hostel authorities will not be responsible for loss of materials.
32. A student has to vacate the hostel along with his luggage at the end of each academic year, within three days after the last day of examination. If a hostler desires to continue for the next academic year, he/she can reserve his/her seat by completing the hostel admission process and making the initial payment of 50,000 which is part of the hostel fee Once the amount is paid, their slot will be booked for the coming session. Rooms will be swapped and students will not get the same room for the next academic year.
33. Students are strictly warned that they should not misuse the social media for any unwanted and criminal activities.
34. **ANY SORT OF MOTOR VEHICLES ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE CAMPUS**
35. **CLOAK ROOM FACILITY TO KEEP LUGGAGE**  
Those students who have completed their hostel admission process for the coming academic session can keep their luggage in the hostel during the brief vacation and can make use of the cloakroom facility. Such students will submit a requisition letter for the same in the prescribed format and take the acknowledgment. Students are suggested to put a lock on every luggage along with an id tag and not to keep their expensive belongings in cloakroom luggage.

Violation of these and any other norms prescribed by the undersigned from time to time, the hostler will be asked to vacate the hostel on disciplinary measure with 24 hours' notice.

\*\*In these cases, the hostler is not only rusticated from the hostel on disciplinary ground, but will also be rusticated from the college without any notice/intimation.

# Annexure - 1

## Dress Code :

1. Within the room, the students have the liberty of wearing the dress of their convenience, but should be decent and acceptable by the hostel authorities.
2. Outside the room, including while going to mess they should wear informal full dress only.
3. While going out of the hostel they must wear the formal dress only.
4. In the college campus students should follow the college dress code. Parents are requested to co-operate in this regard.
