Call for abstracts:

Submitted abstracts will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee. If an abstract is accepted, the author will be requested to send a full-text paper, including results, tables, figures and references. All submissions should report original and previously unpublished research results no matter the type of research paper you are presenting. Full-text papers (.docx and .doc) will be accepted by Electronic Submission Form. Manuscripts should meet the format set by the Conference committee and are subject to review.

Key Highlights:

The selected papers shall be considered for publication in journals (ABDC/ Scopus/ Web of Science/ UGC Care), subject to the adherence of the journals review process. The selected papers submitted and presented in GTFS 2023 will be published as conference proceedings. Best Paper Award will be given in each track.

We will take all efforts to ensure that the publication opportunity is given to the authors in the journals supporting the conference. However, no guarantee is given for publication, as each journal has its mandatory requirements and timelines which have to be satisfied before the paper gets accepted and published. A separate publication fee has to be paid by the authors for publication of their manuscript in conference proceedings by an external publisher or as a journal article, which will be informed officially to the author by the organizing team.
