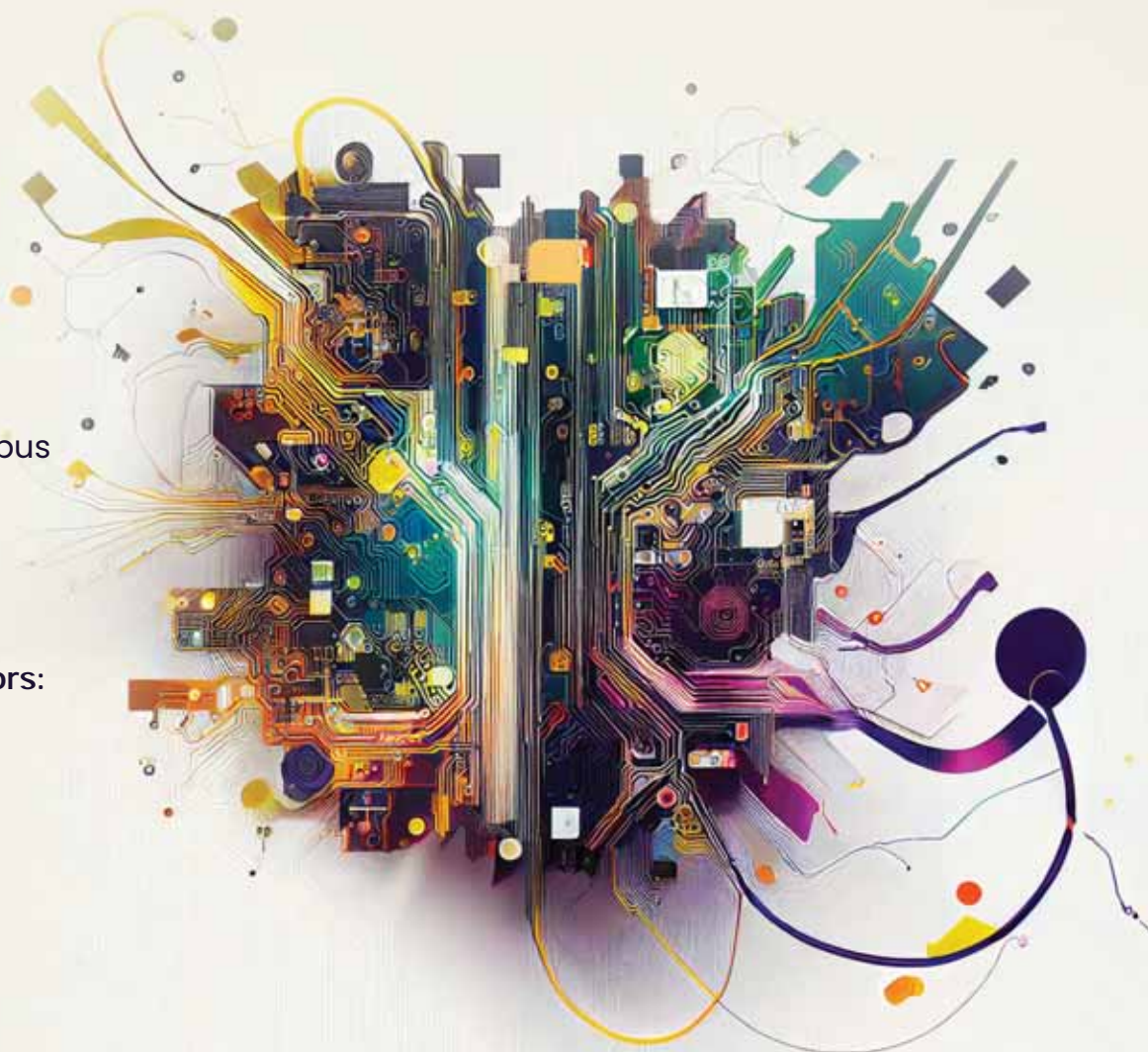

Design a bot or get your readymade remote-controlled vehicle that can sustain over different terrains and intermediate obstacles. Reach the finish line as fast as you can. The bot which completes the track in minimum time will be the winner.

- The robot participating in the competition can be wired/wireless, autonomous or manual.
- The robot must fit into a box of dimension 30cmx30cmx30cm (including the mechanism).
- Any weapon is strictly prohibited.
- The robot weight should be less than 5kg
- The Robot must not emit smoke or fire, leak, stain, or soil • Participants must arrange their batteries
- The Robot must be non-destructive and non-harmful to humans, the track, or the arena.
- Radio systems MUST NOT cause interference to other radio-frequency users.
- The Racetrack/Arena is subject to change before the commencement of any round.
- The decision of the judges will be final and abiding. Arguments with judges in any form will lead to the disqualification of the team right away.
- Time taken in robot adjustment/repair will be included in the given duration (5 min)
- In case of a draw, a tiebreaker round (at the discretion of the judges) will be conducted.
- Robots causing deliberate interference with other robots or damaging tracks will be disqualified
